CZK 2000 BANKNOTE 2007 VERSION





On 2 July 2007 the Czech National Bank will put into circulation a new 2007 version of the CZK 2000 banknote. The banknote is based on the same design and has the same dimensions and parameters as the earlier versions. However, its protection against counterfeiting has been enhanced significantly. The existing protective elements have been changed and new ones added, and other alterations have been made to the design. This poster describes only some of the protective elements, intended for the general public and visible to the naked eye. The other elements are described in the CNB leaflet *CZK 2000 banknote*, 2007 version and at www.cnb.cz.

The main differences on the 2007 version of the CZK 2000 banknote are as follows:



the watermark with a portrait of Emma Destinnová visible against the light now also contains the number 2000 with a small ornament



year 2007



Governor's signature: "Tůma"



bichrome patterned iridescent strip of overlapping gold and blue with recurring negative 2000s



protective strip 3.0 mm wide with recurring hatched negative microtext "ČNB 2000 Kč"



metallic protective strip changes colour from puce to green when tilted
